



USCSA TRANSGENDERED AND NON-BINARY ATHLETE POLICY

VERSION 1.0

ADOPTED: October 10, 2023

The USCSA transgendered & non-binary athlete policy aligns itself with both the NCAA and Olympic Movement, allowing sports governing bodies to establish their own policies. The goal of our policy is to provide a safe, welcoming, inclusive, and competitive environment for all athletes to complete.

Athletes will be held to the following:

- An athlete assigned female at birth who is NOT undergoing testosterone treatment may select a male or female team for the season.
- An athlete assigned female at birth who is undergoing testosterone treatment or medical record of treatment may select a male or female team for the season.
- An athlete assigned male at birth who is NOT undergoing hormone therapy may only compete on a male team.
- An athlete assigned male at birth who is undergoing hormone treatment therapy may select a male or female team for the season.
