

USCSA CHANGE LOG 2023/2024 Competition and Rules Manual

2022 – Changes approved by the USCSA Rules Committee for the Board of Directors in the Rule Making period from October 2022 through August 2023.

1. Snowboard Alpine Discipline

Updated to discipline listing to include SB Alpine separate from SB Freestyle, similar to Alpine Ski and Freeski as separately listed disciplines.

2. USCSA Adaptive Athlete Clarification

Added Adaptive Athlete Definition and Alpine Seeding information.

3. Nordic Technique Rotation at National Championships

Adjusted to ensure the same events are not only used in the Eastern or Western National Championships.

4. Nordic Sprint

Changed USCSA Sprint Flnal Rounds rule to align with FIS rule.

5. Nordic Mass Start

Changed USCSA Mass Start Rule to follow FIS Rule 315.3.1

6. Alpine Regional and National Championships Tie Breaking

Existing Rule Clarification

7. Snowboard Alpine Scoring

Removal of the conditional scoring clause to make Snowboard Alpine a permanently scored event at the National Championships.

8. Wild Card Teams to USCSA National Championships

Replaces Wild Card Team with an additional, permanent, berth for all regions to utilize.

9. Seeding Draw for National Championships

Creation of 2 Alpine Seeding Groups at USCSA National Championships.

10. Nationals Location Reuse

Removal of a rule no longer used.
